

**MEMORANDUM
FOR TRAINING AND ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
THE POLICE ACADEMY OF UZBEKISTAN
AND
THE NATIONAL POLICE ACADEMY OF TURKEY**

The Police Academy of Uzbekistan;

The National Police Academy of Turkey;

(hereinafter referred to as "the Two Participants");

Out of the mutual desire of the Police Academy of Uzbekistan and National Police Academy of the Republic of Turkey to develop cooperation ties, enhance mutual work in all training and academic activities and fields and support efforts of mutual interest;

Have reached the following understanding:

Section 1 **Objectives**

This Memorandum is intended to develop and enhance mutual cooperation and exchange of experiences in training, educational, scientific and which will serve other fields of mutual interest to the Participants.

Section 2 **Areas of Cooperation**

The Participants may cooperate within the competencies thereof and without prejudice to current national laws and regulations as follows:

1. Exchange of visits, experiences and experts in the training and academic fields.
2. With Mutual coordination and cooperation to provide and organise training and educational programmes and activities to serve the interests of the Participants.
3. Exchange of information and opinions on issues of relevance to training and academic activities of mutual interest within the scope of current regulations to the Participants both Participants.
4. Cooperation and Coordination on personnel development in training and academic fields to improve the quality of work for the Participants.

5. Exchange of course structures, training programmes, training and teaching methods, bylaws and regulations on the administrative and scientific system and scientific references and publications, and organisation of different activities, programmes, seminars and conferences of mutual interest to the Participants.
6. Publication of scientific studies, researches and articles in the reviewed scientific journals issued by each Participant.
7. Providing access to electronic libraries of the Participants to staff members, researchers and students
8. Coordination and collaboration between the Two Participants on programmes, courses and other activities provided by the Two Participants in areas of mutual interest

Section 3 **Coordination**

- Cooperation between the Participants will be executed as follows:
- On the side of the Ministry of Interior of Uzbekistan: President of the Police Academy
- On the side of the National Police Academy of Turkey: President of the National Police Academy

Section 4 **Financial Expenses**

1. Unless otherwise agreed upon by the Two Participants, each Participant will be responsible for the financial expenses incurred in relation to the execution of activities and programmes under this Memorandum as per current laws and regulations in each country.
2. Participants will bear travel expenses of its delegations with relevance to the activities and programmes executed under this Memorandum.

Section 5 **Amendments**

This Memorandum of Cooperation may be amended by the written consent of the Two Participants; such amendment will not apply to activities already under implementation unless otherwise agreed upon by the Participants.

Section 6

This Memorandum of Cooperation is concluded with a view to enhancing and developing cooperation between the Participants and does not constitute an international agreement binding upon States of the Participants under international law. No provision of this Memorandum of Cooperation will be interpreted and implemented as creating legal rights or commitments for the States of the Participants. Memorandum of Cooperation may not create any contractual, financial or legal obligations on any of the Two Participants.

Section 7 **Termination**

Any Participant may terminate this Memorandum of Cooperation by serving a written termination notice to the other Participants three months prior to the termination date of this Protocol.

Section 8

1. This Memorandum of Cooperation will become effective as of the date of signing thereof
2. This Memorandum of Cooperation will be valid for the period of three years; automatically renewable for similar periods unless one Participants expresses its desire to terminate it

This Memorandum of Cooperation has been drafted in the city of Ankara on 06/03/2018, in two original counterparts in the Uzbek, Turkish and English languages; with all texts being equally authentic; in case of misinterpretation the English text will prevail.
